In 2022, we spent the whole year building a platform for Adventure Scientists [1] to help them with their mission of matching up data scientists who need environmental data, and adventurers who have the skills to collect that data. The Adventure Scientists team has not launched the platform yet, but they've recently hired someone in-house to manage it, and you can see the platform live at [2]. We also published a few blog posts about our process of working with Adventure Scientists [3] [4]. We also open-sourced a number of libraries as part of building this project.
